This memo is to inform the Curriculum Office of proposed curriculum and departmental changes by the Asian American and Asian Studies department (ASAM) in response to the new CSU Ethnic Studies requirement.

The curriculum and departmental changes are being proposed to meet De Anza's scheduled 2020-21 review process for courses seeking review and approval to fulfill the CSU Ethnic Studies requirement.

ASAM's proposed curriculum and departmental changes fall into five areas:

- I. Courses--as-is or with minor changes--that ASAM plans to submit for review for the new CSU Ethnic Studies requirement (9 courses)
- II. Courses to be moved to a new Ethnic Studies department based on common disciplinary identification practices (2 courses)
- III. New ASAM courses in anticipation of cross-listing to be made by existing non-Ethnic Studies courses (1 course)

ASAM understands any curriculum changes will need to be made through De Anza's standard and soon-be-established curriculum protocols (i.e., ECMS entry, curriculum paperwork, future entry in eLumen).
