

Structure

1. The members of the Administration Committee will introduce the complaints
2. Complainants will present their complaints and all evidence including statements from individuals involved and witnesses (must be present in person or over Zoom)
3. Candidates in complaints will provide a response if present
4. The Senate will ask questions of complainants, individuals involved, witnesses, and candidates in the complaints
5. Complainants, individuals involved, witnesses, and candidates in the complaints may raise their hands to speak and if called upon may address the Senate
6. Once the open discussion period has ended, the Senate will publicly deliberate on the complaints (everyone must remain quiet during the deliberation period)
7. The Senate will make any motions as appropriate
8. All decisions of the Senate are final and cannot be appealed
