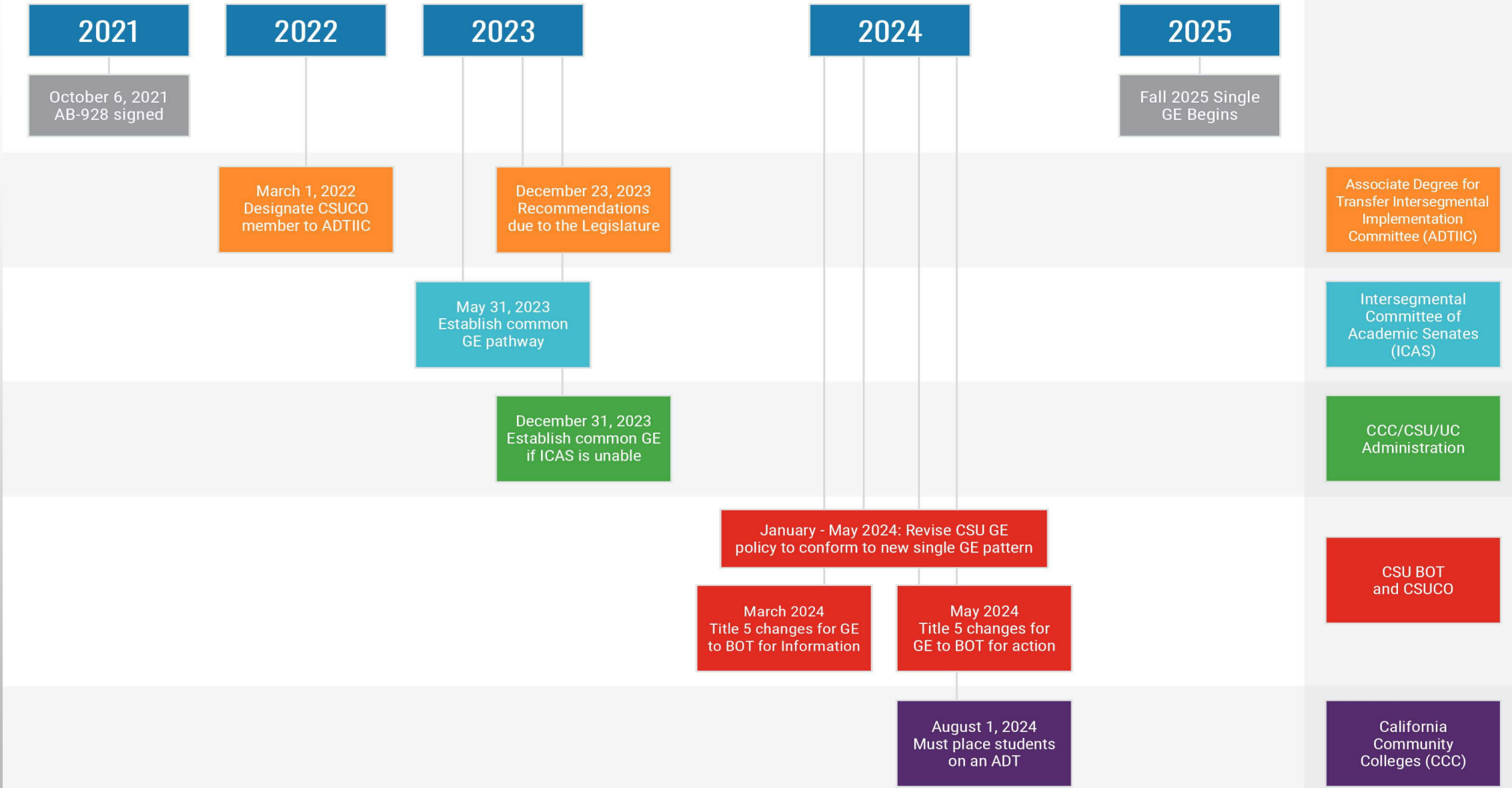

# OVERVIEW OF AB 928

- Requires Intersegmental Committee of the Academic Senates (ICAS) to establish **a single lower division general education pathway** that meets the academic requirements necessary for transfer into both CSU and UC (establish by **May 2023**, implement **fall 2025**) and to not lengthen the time-to-degree or include more units than those required under IGETC. The bill requires this singular lower division general education pathway to be the **only lower division general education pathway used to determine eligibility and sufficient academic preparation for transfer into both segments.**  
*Note: the single lower division general education pathway will apply to UC if the Regents adopt an appropriate resolution.*
- Establishes the Associate Degree for Transfer Intersegmental Implementation Committee to serve as the primary entity charged with the oversight of the ADT. (16 members, by **12/23** will provide Legislature with recommendations on certain issues impeding the scaling of the ADT and streamlining transfer across segments)
- Requires CCCs to automatically place students on ADT pathways by August 2024 when pathways for their transfer goals (majors identified on ed plans) exist.

**IGETC** is not appropriate for most high-unit majors, such as Engineering and the sciences, which require extensive lower-division major preparation. Check [www.ASSIST.org](http://www.ASSIST.org) for more information.

The following are general campus guidelines for UC. **IGETC may not be accepted or recommended for the following:**

- **Berkeley** – Colleges of Engineering and Chemistry, and Haas School of Business. Though IGETC satisfies certain breadth requirements for most majors in the College of Natural Resources, it does not fully satisfy lower-division requirements for CNR majors. Check [www.ASSIST.org](http://www.ASSIST.org) for details.
- **Davis** – Bachelor of Science degree programs and selective majors
- **Los Angeles** – School of Engineering applicants are encouraged to focus on lower-division major preparation prior to transfer.
- **Merced** – Schools of Engineering and Natural Sciences applicants are encouraged to focus on lower-division major preparation prior to transfer.
- **Riverside** – College of Natural and Agricultural Sciences and The Marlan and Rosemary Bourns College of Engineering accept IGETC but additional coursework may be required after enrollment.
- **San Diego** – Revelle College IGETC does not clear all lower-division GE requirements. Students with IGETC are required to complete 3 courses in mathematics and 5 courses in natural science before transfer or while enrolled at UCSD.
- **Santa Barbara** – College of Engineering students are encouraged to focus on major preparation rather than GE but may use IGETC to substitute for GE requirements.
- **Santa Cruz** – Majors in engineering and the physical and biological sciences.
- **Former UC students returning to the same campus cannot use IGETC. CSU does not have a system-wide policy, so students should check with campuses.**

**POLI** 1/1H and **one** of the following U.S. History courses: **HIST** 17A/17AH or 17B/17BH or 17C/17CH

**POLI** 1/1H may be applied to Area D and **HIST** 17A/17AH, 17B/17BH, or 17C/17CH may be applied towards Area C or Area D. **However, it is at the discretion of each CSU campus to allow courses to double count towards both AI and GE requirements.**

Completion of requirements on the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) will permit a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the California State University (CSU) or the University of California (UC) system without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division, general education courses to satisfy campus general education requirements. All courses must be completed with grades of "C" or better OR with a "Pass" if the course was taken on a Pass/No Pass (P/NP) basis and the Pass is equal to a "C" grade or higher. Many colleges and universities require letter grades for major coursework, and/or have other restrictions on P/NP grades. Students are advised to consult with a counselor/academic adviser before selecting the P/NP option. A course is certifiable if, and only if, it was on the IGETC requirement list at the time the course was taken. See a counselor/academic adviser about UC majors, colleges, and professional schools which do not accept IGETC, and for other transfer requirements.
