

### Maintain ICS Requirement **Intercultural Studies**

- Require an additional course approved for ICS in area 3, 4, or 7.
- Allows double count for area and graduation requirement.
- Currently, 7 out of 34 DA Ethnic Studies courses have been approved as IGETC and CSU GE.
- CSU approval in the near future.
