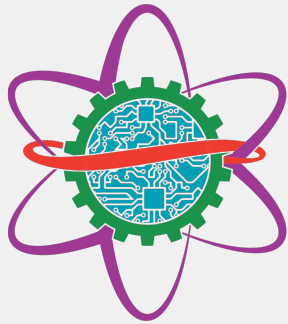

Science Achievement

1. Be a current, full-time De Anza student
2. Be pursuing a major in Math, Engineering, Science etc that requires Calculus 1 (Math 1A). (Unfortunately Nursing and Public Health are *excluded* majors)
3. Plan to transfer to pursue a Bachelor's degree in the STEM field
4. Must be eligible for financial aid
5. Able to meet certain criteria to be considered educationally disadvantaged (be a first generation college student- we can help figure this out with you as there's some gray area)

MESA 2 year recap

- 112 students currently served
- 2 MESA Scholarships awarded
- 7 student ambassadors per year
- 4 NeuroCC Research Internships w/ Stanford University
- 10-15 student tutors for Precalculus, Calculus, Biology (6 series-Micro), Physics, Chemistry (General & Organic)
- 1-2 events per week ranging in topics on transfer, resume/cover letter, internship opportunities, conferences or field trips

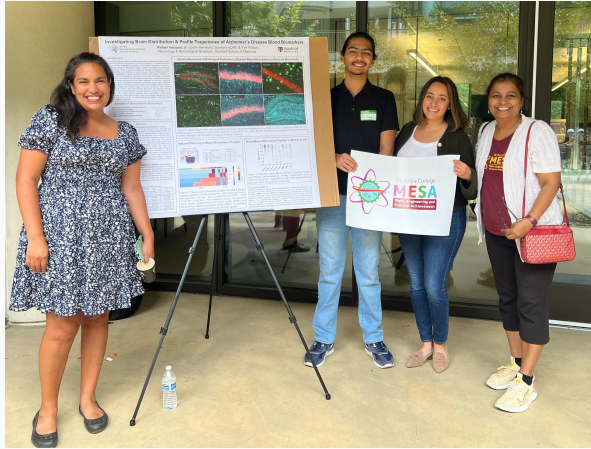

Priority Registration:

Group 1-A

Veterans, foster youth, DSPS, EOPS and CalWorks students who have

- completed orientation, assessment and an educational plan

Group 1-B

Student parents who have

- one or more children under age 18 who receive more than half their support from the student parent
- completed orientation, assessment and an educational plan

Group 2

Student athletes who have

- Selected an educational goal of transfer, degree or certificate
- Declared a major and have not been on probation for two consecutive terms
(If first admit quarter is summer 2014 or later, student will be considered a first-time college student and **must** have completed assessment, passed orientation and completed an educational plan.)

Group 3

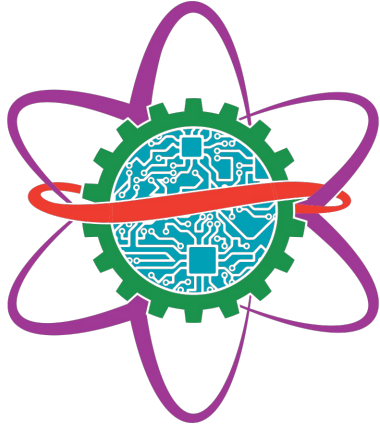
Continuing students who have

- Selected an educational goal of transfer, degree or certificate
- Declared a major and have not been on probation for two consecutive terms
- Completed orientation, assessment and an educational plan

REGISTRATION DATES EXAMPLE:

February 20	Group 2 registration opens
February 24	Group 3 registration opens

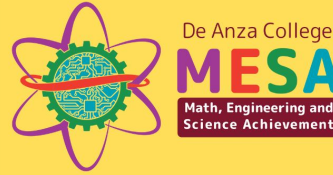
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
