Subject: Title IX Student Survey, Spring 2021

The Title IX online survey was sent by the Office of Communications to students enrolled during spring 2021 quarter. Of the 16,021 student enrollees, a random sample of 7,000 received the survey link. A total of 217 responses were collected between May 18, 2021 and May 28, 2020 for a response rate of 3%.

Survey Highlights

Demographics

- Most of the survey respondents have attended De Anza for 8 or more quarters (30%), followed by 2 to 3 quarters (28%) and 6 to 7 quarters (22%).
- Respondents are likely to be between 18 to 24 years old (59%), Asian (41%) or White (32%), female (62%) and heterosexual (62%).

General Climate

- 76% (166) of respondents "agreed" or "strongly agreed" they feel safe at De Anza.
- 35% (77) of respondents "agreed" or "strongly agreed" they know where to report sexual harassment and/or sexual misconduct issues on campus.
- 61% (133) of respondents "agreed" or "strongly agreed" they would feel comfortable reporting sexual harassment and/or sexual misconduct issues to a De Anza employee.
- 30% (65) of respondents "agreed" or "strongly agreed" there is a good support system for De Anza students who report sexual harassment and/or sexual misconduct.

Leadership, Policies and Reporting Perceptions

- 60% (131) of respondents agreed" or "strongly agreed" they have confidence that De Anza will apply the formal procedures to address complains of sexual misconduct fairly.
- 77% (167) of respondents indicated it is "moderately likely" or "extremely likely" De Anza would take corrective action against the offender. When probed if their response would be the same if the offender was an employee of the college, 68% (148) of respondents indicated it is "moderately likely" or "extremely likely."
- 69% (150) of respondents indicated it is "moderately likely" or "extremely likely" De Anza would take steps to protect the person making the report from retaliation.

- 14% (31) of respondents have completed the eCheckup To Go Sexual Violence Prevention Program located in MyPortal. Among these respondents, 58% (18) felt the training was useful.
- 29% (63) of respondents know where to find Sexual Harassment/Title IX information on the college website.
- 6% (13) have referred to the Title IX website or filed a report.

Behavior and Consent

- Respondents were asked to rate on a scale from 0 to 5, with 0 being not likely and 5 being extremely likely, how likely they were to engage in activities listed below. Results are summarized for responses rated as a 4 or 5.
 - 79% (172) of respondents were likely to ask for verbal consent when they are intimate with their partner, even if their relationship is long term.
 - 91% (197) of respondents were likely to stop having sex with a partner if they say to stop, even if the sexual activity started consensually.
 - 82% (177) of respondents were likely to not have sex with a partner if they were drunk.
 - 90% (195) of respondents were likely to stop sexual activity when asked to, even if they were already sexually aroused.
 - 83% (181) of respondents were likely to confront a friend who plans to give someone alcohol to get sex.
 - 86% (186) of respondents were likely to confront a friend who is hooking up with someone who is passed out.
 - 70% (151) of respondents were likely to challenge a friend who uses insulting words to describe someone.
 - 66% (144) of respondents were likely to challenge a friend who made a sexist joke.

Sexual Assault Perceptions

- Respondents were asked to rate on a scale from 1 to 5, with 1 being strongly disagree and 5 being strongly agree, their level of agreement with the statements listed below. Results are summarized for responses rated as a 4 or 5.
 - 12% (27) of respondents were likely to agree when people go to parties wearing revealing clothes, they are asking for trouble.
 - 8% (17) of respondents were likely to agree if someone goes to a room alone with another person at a party, it is their own fault if they are sexually assaulted.
 - 30% (66) of respondents were likely to agree sexual assault can happen when someone is hooking up with a lot of people.
 - 12% (25) of respondents were likely to agree that sexual assault is unlikely to happen by someone they know.

- 13% (29) of respondents were likely to agree that people do not usually tend to sexually assault another person, but sometimes they get too sexually carried away.
- 12% (25) of respondents were likely to agree that if someone is sexually assaulted while they were drunk, they are at least someone responsible for what happened.
- 23% (49) of respondents were likely to agree that if someone is drunk, they might sexually assault someone unintentionally.
- 6% (14) of respondents were likely to agree that if someone does not physically fight back, they cannot really say they were sexually assaulted.
- 10% (22) of respondents were likely to agree that if someone does not say "no," they cannot claim sexual assault.
- 10% (21) of respondents were likely to agree that people who say they were sexually assaulted agreed to have sex and then regretted it.

Sexual Misconduct

- 9% (20) of respondents have experienced unwanted behavior on campus, in an online class, or through a college sponsored activity?
- Respondents were probed about the unwanted behavior and whether they confided in anyone. Answer choices were provided and respondents could select more than one response. Respondents indicated the type of unwanted behavior was sexual harassment (11), stalking (10) and/or touching of a sexual nature (9). Respondents indicated they told no one (12) or confided in a close friend other than a roommate (12) and/or a romantic partner (6). Those who did not confide in anyone about the unwanted behavior indicated they wanted to forget it happened (9), felt ashamed/embarrassed (8) and/or did not think others would think it was serious (7).
- 16% (35) of respondents have experienced unwanted contact while drinking alcohol or after.
- 6% (13) of respondents have been drugged without their consent.


